Beattie	Our CELDT scores are in and we will be treating all of our ELL students to ice cream “drumsticks” at lunch if their Scores improved from last years’.
Bryn Mawr	Intervention classes have transitioned from Hampton Brown to the Journeys EL support supplemental program. Our second ELAC is scheduled for January 20, 2015. Topics covered: school plan and budget. ELAC elections will also take place.
Clement	There will be an ELAC meeting at Lugonia on Friday January 16th at 8:00 am and at Judson Brown on Monday January 26th at 7:45 am. Clement will be hosting the Multicultural Fair on May 16th. CVHS, RHS, RHS	First Wave of Redesignations on their way. We are redesignating 23 at RHS, 14 at CVHS, and 11 at REV. We have 41 EL Seniors at RHS, only 4 have not passed CAHSEE, 27 Seniors at CV with 2 still needing to pass the CAHSEE , and 18 Seniors at REV, all have passed. February 3 and 4 will be CAHSEE test for 10th graders. Next ELAC meeting 2/05/15.
Highland Grove	Our winter concert was a huge success! Our 4th graders will be taking a field trip this Friday, January 16th (Redlands Heritage Tour).
