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CA Dashboard gauges RUSD's measurable gains

REDLANDS, CA – California unveiled a new website designed to help communities across the state access important information about K-12 schools and districts – including ours, called the California Dashboard.

The Dashboard is the next step in a series of major shifts in public education as a result of 2013's Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF.)

California has raised the bar for student learning, transformed testing and placed the focus on equity for all students.

Redlands Unified is making district-wide leaps and bounds in terms of progress, due first and foremost to our diligent and dedicated teachers and staff.

They have seamlessly and effectively transitioned to this new accountability system and new state Common Core standards.

The Dashboard helps us illustrate our achievements within its Equity Report. This report includes multiple measures of school success including test scores, graduation rates, English learner progress and suspension rates.

The Dashboard's multiple indicators give a more complete picture of a school's progress and reports on growth to show a school's trajectory over time.

In the last year, approximately 75% of our schools have either maintained or experienced significant growth according to our Equity Report.

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The Dashboard allows us to quantitatively see how we measure up against similar districts across the state as well. Based on this comparison, we are doing significantly well.

Additionally, we attribute our widespread, measurable success throughout our schools to the forethought and resolve of our Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) Advisory Committee.

Our LCAP Advisory Committee uses data to identify, develop and implement programs and services in order to achieve our district's overall vision and goals.

The Dashboard allows us to see the overall effectiveness of our LCAP programs so that we can ensure academic success for all of our students.

The emphasis of Redlands Unified School District has been on college and career readiness, implementing educational technology, and increasing the opportunities for training and coaching to our educators.

While we are filled with immense pride in our achievements and celebrate our success, we remain steadfast in our resolve to focus on our student groups that may need extra support and align our resources in order to best serve them.
